## **WHAT ARE YOUR PAYMENT OPTIONS?**

- Ideally, as a once off payment as per the Donation Form attached – note you can also donate online at [www.skerriesharps.ie](http://www.skerriesharps.ie)
- Should you be in a position to take out a loan with any financial institution, your repayments on a loan of €1,000 over say 2 years would be approx. €50 per month
- By monthly standing order – see form attached
- If any donator is an Irish PAYE tax payer, under the Government's Tax Rebate Scheme to registered clubs, we can claim back tax already paid by you on your donation. In order to qualify for this scheme, your donation to the club in any one tax year must be €250 or more i.e. €250 would be required prior to 31.12.2014 in order to qualify for this year or a minimum monthly payment of €21 would be required in order to qualify for subsequent years. Attached is the form required for submission to the Revenue if appropriate.

**Skerries Harps New Clubhouse Donations - Tax benefits to the Club / You**

**Example 1 - PAYE worker (who does not file an Income Tax Return each year)**

***If person making donation pays tax at marginal rate of 41% -***

Cash Donation made	€1,000
Tax refund claimed by Skerries Harps	<u>€695</u>
Total Value of donation to Club	<u><u>€1,695</u></u>

***If person making donation pays tax at lower rate of 20% -***

Cash Donation made	€1,000
Tax refund claimed by Skerries Harps	<u>€250</u>
Total Value of donation to Club	<u><u>€1,250</u></u>

Although the cash donation is the same, the Club receives a high tax rebate thereby increasing the total amount of the donation if the marginal tax rate was paid.

**Example 2 - Self employed or PAYE work who files Tax Return each year**

***If person making donation pays tax at marginal rate of 41% -***

Cash Donation made	€1,000
Tax deduction to be taken by tax payer	<u>€410</u>
After tax cost of donation to tax payer	<u><u>€590</u></u>

***If person making donation pays tax at standard rate of 20% -***

Cash Donation made	€1,000
Tax deduction to be taken by tax payer	<u>€200</u>
After tax cost of donation to tax payer	<u><u>€800</u></u>

The Club receives the same amount of cash donation in these examples but the after tax cost is different due to the different tax rates applying.

## NOTES

1. An Approved Sports Body means a body which is in possession of:
  - ◆ a certificate from the Revenue Commissioners stating that in their opinion the body is a body to which Section 235 TCA 1997 applies and,
  - ◆ a valid tax clearance certificate,

but does not include a body to whom the Revenue Commissioners have given notice under Section 235(1) TCA 1997.

2. The phrase “grossed up amount of the donation” means the amount, which after deducting income tax leaves the amount of the donation.

### Examples of Donations for the 2010 tax year:

- ◆ On the **standard rate** of 20%, the grossed up amount of a donation of €250 is €312.50 (i.e.  $€250 \times 100 \div 80$ ). The tax associated with the donation is €62.50.
- ◆ On the **higher rate** of 41%, the grossed up amount of a donation of €250 is €423.73 (i.e.  $€250 \times 100 \div 59$ ). The tax associated with the donation is €173.73.

## Repayment of tax to the Approved Sports Body

For repayment purposes, the details contained in the Appropriate Certificates must subsequently be forwarded by approved sports bodies to Revenue at the end of the tax year in an agreed format together with a completed **Form 847A Donations Scheme**, available on Revenue’s website [www.revenue.ie](http://www.revenue.ie) or from any Revenue office.

All repayment claims should be sent to your local Revenue office.
